Trustees and administration attending the meeting were introduced.

5 Division Update (Tr. Grant)

Trustee Grant shared highlights from the PWPSD Division Update (attached) with attendees:

- Dialogue Partners was hired by PWPSD administration in early 2023 to guide a conversation around junior high programming in the communities of Beaverlodge and Hythe. Dialogue Partners will be presenting to the Board on April 27, 2023.
- Alberta Education announced on March 14 that the walk limit would be lowered to 1 km for students in Kindergarten to Grade 6 and to 2 km for students in Grades 7-12.
- The province approved planning funding for a new high school to replace existing Peace Wapiti Academy.

6 ASCA Conference and AGM Information (Tr. Grant)

Trustee Grant provided information about the Alberta School Council Association's Annual Conference and AGM being held on April 23 and 24, 2023.

7 Keynote Speaker - Dr. Lisa Belanger (Asst. Supt. O'Shea)

Dr. Lisa Belanger gave an interactive presentation on a variety of mental health topics:

- transitioning back from the pandemic and supporting increased behaviors and academic gaps
- supporting mental wellness in children (anxiety for example)

Guiding Our Future

In early 2023, PWPSD Administration hired Dialogue Partners, a community engagement consulting firm, to help guide a conversation around junior high programming in Beaverlodge and Hythe. The Guiding Our Future team met with students, staff, parents and community members in Beaverlodge, Hythe, and Horse Lake First Nation to hear their thoughts and collect feedback to share with the Board. A final report of what we heard will be shared later this spring.





Transportation to be offered to more students

Beginning in September 2023, more PWPSD students will qualify for free transportation to and from school. The Province announced on March 14 that the walk limit would be lowered from the current 2.4 km to 1 km for students in Kindergarten–Grade 6 and to 2 km for students in Grades 7–12.
