Those without internet access should contact the school for assistance. To register online or in-person you will need:

- · Your child's birth certificate
- · Proof of residency
- · Copy of any court orders affecting your child

SCHOOL START-UP

Some schools begin the school year with staggered entry – introducing small groups of Kindergarten students to the school on different days – while others choose to delay the start of Kindergarten until after older students have settled back into the school routine. In August, start-up dates and times are posted under the "Registration" link on school websites.

FREE TRANSPORTATION

PWPSD provides free transportation to students who qualify due to distance from their designated school. Before the first day of school, bus drivers call parents to provide the bus route number, along with pick-up and drop-off times.
